#### **Church Building Team Update:**

- Each of the fourteen Stations of the Cross from the fire-damaged church structure have been expertly refurbished by one of our local skilled artists. The Stations are being readied for installation in our New Worship Space. Our thanks to the volunteer who worked tirelessly on this project and to the many other volunteers assisting with our parish's new church project.
- The Construction Committee is working on interior design and options for the beams, the stone and the glass of our New Worship Space and Gathering Space. These are three seemingly simple items but individually and as a group they will significantly impact the interior appearance and feel of both the Worship Space as well as the Gathering Space.
- The ground work at the site of the New Church is being prepared. A large amount of excavating has occurred along with the placement of much new fill.


