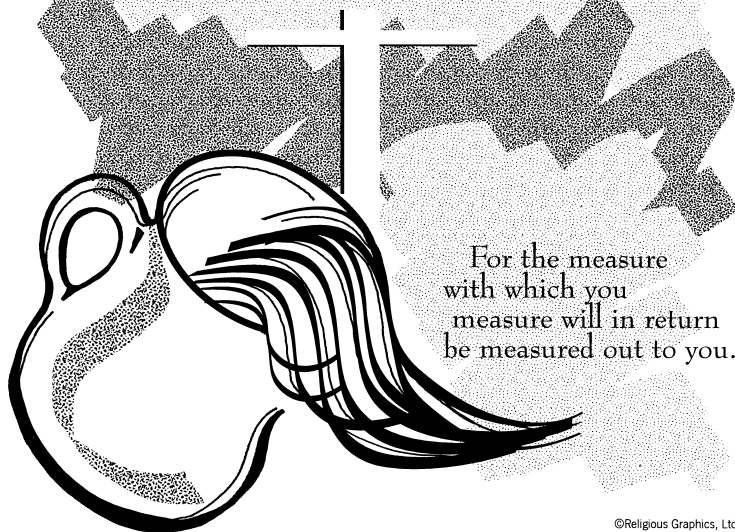

On Liturgy – Inside the Church: Altar Servers--Chris Calderone

While attending Catholic elementary school in New York, it was my fourth-grade class that was the first to receive altar server training for both girls and boys. This is one of many examples in the past decades of a positive shift in our Church’s understanding of lay ecclesial ministry. The faces of those who might serve as altar servers may have changed in recent decades, but the function and role of altar servers – known in the Roman Missal as acolytes – have experienced very little change, even in decades before the Second Vatican Council. Our parish’s altar servers will likely experience an easy transition to ministering in the new church. They will still process in and out with a cross, candles, and incense as appropriate to the solemnity. They will still sit within the sanctuary and hold the Roman Missal for the presider. They will still “serve the altar” and assist the priest in preparing the gifts of bread and wine and their sacred vessels, and they will still assist with other liturgical functions as necessary. Can altar servers expect any differences in our new church?

Similar to the ministry of the sacristans, the largest change will be more space for ministers. Our church should have not only a spacious sacristy, but also a spacious area for altar servers to vest and prepare for the liturgy. This should include well-planned and accessible places for the processional cross, candles, incense, holy water, and other items pertinent to their ministry. Seating for altar servers within the sanctuary, including extra seats for solemnities, should not be an after-thought.

Altar servers do indeed “serve the church”, but our new church should likewise do its part to serve the needs of this time-honored ministry.
