

### On Liturgy – Jesus Finds Us on Easter -- Chris Calderone

Mary of Magdala, accompanied by other women, came to the tomb early in the morning. Instead of finding Jesus there, two angels asked them, "Why do you seek the living among the dead?" They are the first to know that Jesus has been raised from the dead, and they run from the empty tomb to tell the world.

Alleluia! Christ is risen! We continue to celebrate this news each year at Easter, and proclaim it by our very lives as Christians. We run from the empty tomb, for we know that Jesus is not there, but is alive in God and in us. We tell the world to seek Christ – not among the dead, but among the living, today and always.

Where do we seek Christ in church? In the Blessed Sacrament? In the tabernacle? On the crucifix, or in the Stations of the Cross? Or perhaps we find Christ in the Word of God? In the assembly of people gathered for worship? In the light that streams through windows? Is Christ found in song or in silence; inside or outside?

There is no right or wrong here. Furthermore, we are reminded this Easter season that Jesus finds us where we are and where we need him. In the coming weeks we will hear Jesus appearing to disciples in the upper room, on the seashore, in the Breaking of the Bread. Today, we need not seek Jesus in a singular place, like a tomb. Instead, Jesus finds each of us in infinite ways and places, and his message is always the same: "Peace be with you."
