

On Liturgy - The Paschal Triduum

Today is the Second Sunday of Lent. Holy Week is still over a month away. Let's jump forward to Holy Week anyway... particularly, the Paschal Triduum. The Triduum: the three sacred liturgies of Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and the Easter Vigil. But why? Why jump ahead?

The Roman Missal prefaces these holy liturgies as follows: "In the Sacred Triduum, the Church solemnly celebrates the greatest mysteries of our redemption, keeping by means of special celebrations the memorial of her Lord, crucified, buried, and risen." The Mass of the Lord's Supper, the Good Friday liturgy, and the sacrament-filled Easter Vigil are some of our most sacred and liturgically rich celebrations of the entire year. They are also some of our most complex liturgies: we wash feet, we venerate the wood of the Cross, and we dispel the darkness with the Light of Christ. These rituals stick with us throughout our lives, and we return to them each year. As such, they are fantastic starting places in the process of building a church. We can wonder and imagine how these sacred and timeless rituals will look, sound, and feel in a new worship space. If our new church can effectively facilitate a community's celebration of the Paschal Triduum, it will be ready for anything! The next three columns will focus on one day of the Triduum at a time: Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and the Easter Vigil. Before we start imagining, let's start remembering. What are the sights, sounds, smells, and sensations you remember from Holy Thursday as a child? Do you remember the size and shape of the cross you may have venerated year after year on Good Friday? Perhaps some of you or your loved ones were baptized and confirmed at the Easter Vigil...when and where? Let's talk and share together how we "Do this in memory of Me".


