#### Parish Council message

- The Parish Council is collaborating with the Church Building Team, Diocese of St. Cloud, and legal council as we have begun the process of closure of the Fire-Damaged Former Church Structure. This is a complicated process that will include the procurement of several demolition-related permits and may initially include the removal of the piano, Marian altar, stained glass windows and other interior contents.
- We intend to plan and organize a parish "liturgy of remembrance" for the fire-damaged former church building.
- It is our goal to move through this process in a healing and respectful manner of closure for our parish community.
- We are grateful for your prayers, work and support in this process.



#### On Liturgy – The Council Continues -- Chris Calderone

The Second Vatican Council, more than 50 years behind us, continues to have lasting effects on the way the Church worships. We have explored several ways that the Council affects the way churches are designed today. Often, one if not several subsequent Church documents further clarify, define, and provide guidance in light of the 1963 Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy. It is worth recognizing that this process has been ongoing for 50 years, and it will surely continue.

Following the 2011 English Translation of the Roman Missal, all rites are slowly being revised. The Revised Rite of Marriage was released just this past year. Two weeks ago, we explored the Rites of Initiation, particularly Baptism, which were revised following Vatican II. The Order of Baptism for adults and children is currently under revision. Perhaps of greatest interest to our new church project is the impending release of the revised Rite of Dedication of a Church and Altar. Many of the changes reflect the language changes made in the Roman Missal, but each revision affords the opportunity for the Church to explore, develop, and revise the way in which sacraments and rituals are celebrated by the Church.

This is not exclusively the work of bishops or of the Vatican. We, as a community of faith, continue to grow in our understanding of how we worship God and worship together. As active participants in sacred liturgy, we continually shape the liturgical worship of the community into something that connects each and all of us with the divine.


