

On Liturgy – Inside the Church: Music (Gr. 9!)--*Chris Calderone* After much talk and discussion about the new church building itself, it is worth exploring all that will happen inside our new church. We are all aware that the church facilitates worship, while it is the gathered community - the Body of Christ, the Church - that celebrates the liturgies and worship that take place inside the church. We each play a part, and I want to highlight some of those roles that the new church will facilitate.

In December, I had the opportunity to show the 9th Grade Faith Formation class a unique part of my work: music selections. Students learned what the Church says about selecting music for liturgies, as well as how music can help – or hinder – people as they worship God. They were then divided into groups, each group tasked with selecting music for two Sundays of Ordinary Time. They read and discussed the Scripture readings for the day, then used the same resources I use to select appropriate music for the Masses. By the end of the class, they had selected most of the music to be used for Masses between January 20th and February 24th. I was quite impressed with their insights and their selections, and kept most of their suggestions, so you can thank the 9th Graders for their selections – starting today!

Is this related to our new church? Yes it is! The most direct impact on music selections will be the transition to projector screens. With the screens, we will no longer be bound to hymnals and the music found only in that hymnal. Instead, we will be able to select music from any publisher for use during worship.
