

Bishop's Annual Appeal: Thank you to everyone who is supporting diocesan minis-

As of June 29, the Appeal raised \$1,013,905 in gifts and pledges toward the goal \$1,300,000. Act as liaison between all One in Faith parishes and the Worship Office of the Diocese of St. Cloud
