

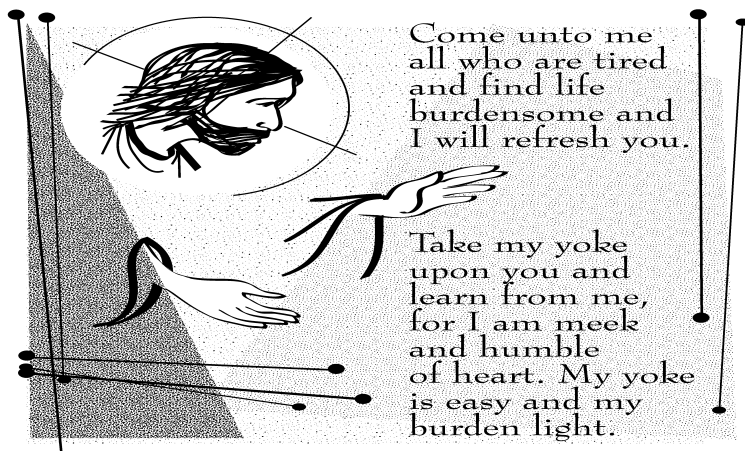

Responsibilities:

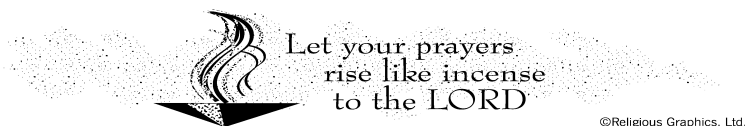
- Plan and coordinate all liturgies, music, and musicians for parish liturgical celebrations at St. Mary's

- Coordinate with the Faith Formation Coordinator in the preparation of First Reconciliation, First Communion, and Confirmation
- Meet with couples and families to prepare and celebrate wedding and funeral liturgies at St. Mary's
- Oversee the use and maintenance of church sound, video, and musical equipment at St. Mary's
- Oversee the on-going training and formation of liturgical ministers in all One in Faith parishes
- Act as liaison between all One in Faith parishes and the Worship Office of the Diocese of St. Cloud

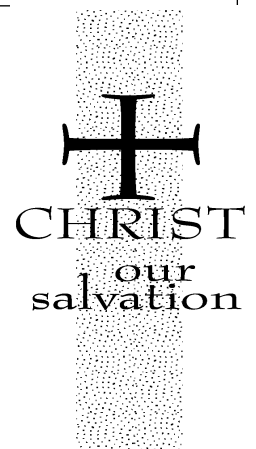
