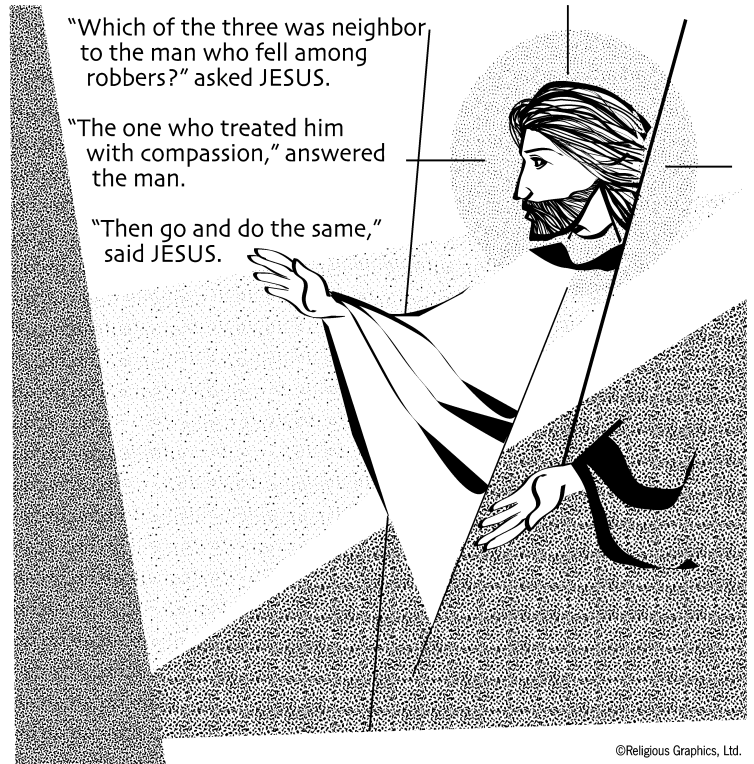

Free and open to the public: Hours: Tuesday-Friday 10 a.m. - 4 p.m./Saturday & Sunday 1 p.m. - 3:30 p.m. Education was a foundational ministry for the Sisters of Saint Benedict’s Monastery. Hundreds of sisters staffed over 100 elementary schools within the St. Cloud Diocese and beyond. Catholic elementary education saw a peak in sister-teacher and pupil enrollment from 1955-1965. The exhibit A Legacy of Learning features St. Mary’s School of Melrose and three other schools. This exhibit is free and open to the public until Friday, December 2016.
