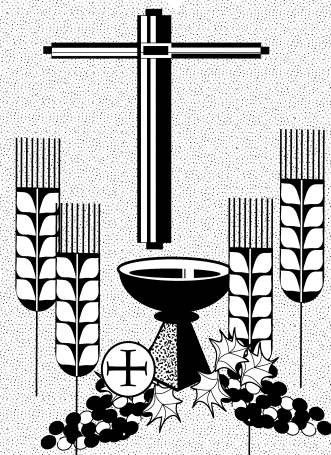

**On Liturgy – Blessing the Land --Chris Calderone**

You have likely heard or read about the Site Blessing with Mass, to take place on September 9th on the land that our new church will be built upon. Much of these “On Liturgy” messages have focused on liturgical aspects of the new church itself, but the planning of this event has me focused on liturgical aspects of the building process itself. This celebration on September 9th will be the first of many rites and rituals on our journey toward our new church’s completion!

The Church outlines some of these rituals in the “Rite of the Dedication of a Church and an Altar”. Much like Christ as the Beginning and the End, this sacred rite encompasses both the beginning and the end of a new church’s construction with two parts that take place at two different times. The “Rite of Beginning Work on the Building of a Church” blesses the site of the new church, as well as the start of construction, and normally takes place at groundbreaking. The “Dedication of a Church” marks the end of construction and the beginning of the building’s use for worship.

The Site Blessing that we will celebrate on September 9th is not the same as the rite we will celebrate with groundbreaking, but its importance should not be diminished. By gathering on the grounds of the new church for Mass and fellowship, once-fallow land will become sacred, planted with our hopes and prayers for a new church and a new place to worship God. Come to bless this land!
