

On Liturgy – The Place for the Assembly -- Chris Calderone Recent conversations about the new church design revolve around the seating arrangement for the assembly. Those who remember the drawings presented to the public in February may remember a pew layout that is quite different from those found in long, narrow churches and more typical of modern design. Did the Second Vatican Council influence even this detail of church design? Yes! The influence, however, evolved from the fundamental drive of the Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy (SC): the "full, active, and conscious participation of the assembly". Beyond this, SC only directed that "no special preference is to be accorded any private persons or classes of persons" (SC 32). The 1964 Instruction for the Implementation of SC states that the faithful and the choir shall have a place that facilitates their participation, and that the assembly must be able to both see and hear the celebrant and other ministers easily, using modern technology to do so. (IO 97-98) The combined desire for active participation and equality among the assembly inspired statements in the General Instructions of the Roman Missal, which calls for arrangement of the assembly in a manner that expresses the "unity of the entire holy people" (GIRM 294). From this, the USCCB writes in "Built of Living Stones": "The community worships as a single body united in faith, not simply as individuals who happen to find themselves in one place, and that...the priest celebrant and ministers together with the congregation form the liturgical assembly". (BLS 52)


